## Riverfront Phase I

Meewasin is undertaking the development of Riverfront Phase I (between the Traffic Bridge and the Senator Sid Buckwold Bridge) and Riverfront Phase II (between the Senator Sid Buckwold Bridge and Victoria Park). Meewasin's Manager of Design & Development Landscape Architect, Lloyd Isaak, is responsible for managing both projects.

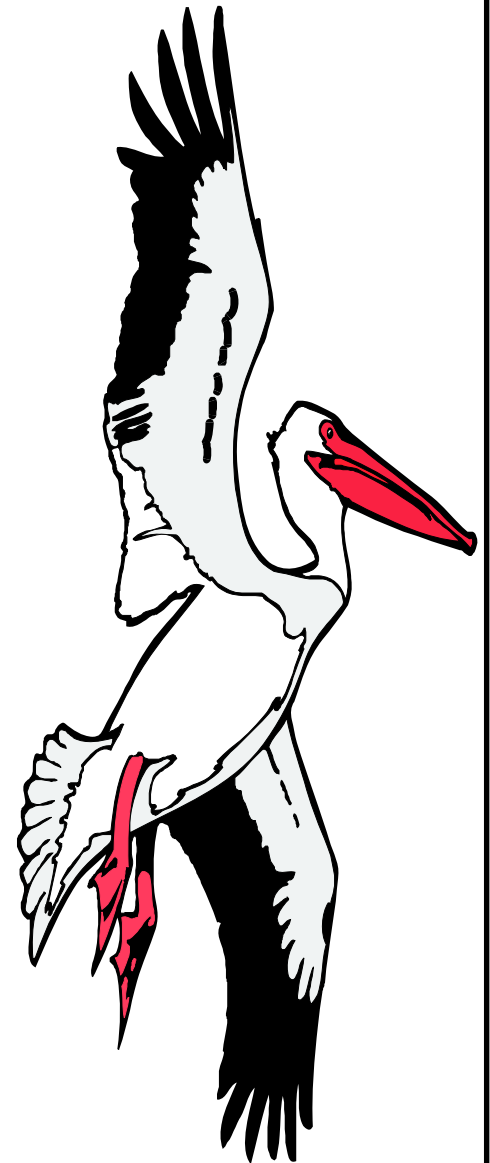

Plans for Phase I this spring include the completion of the suspension bridge, river walk, lighting, plantings and site furnishings. The Meewasin trail along the river and the floating dock next to the Traffic Bridge are targeted to be open to the public later this summer. In addition, the construction of the pavilion, the amphitheatre and the pedestrian service links will begin this summer.

Plans for a water feature (a water play area) are in the development phase. This will be a major feature of the site, covering approximately 30,000 square feet. This feature will model the Saskatchewan River Basin geographically, naturally and culturally. The water feature is a play area with educational value, and the design plans for it to be attractive, durable and unique.

The Cameco Riverfront Campaign will be starting shortly and will provide sponsorship opportunities to assist with the funding of the Riverfront Phase I project, an \$11 million project.
