**POSITION**

Labourer (Rink Attendant)

**PURPOSE**

Under the supervision of the Construction Supervisor, the Labourer (Rink Attendant) will operate the Meewasin Skating Rink.

**DUTIES**

Under the supervision of the Construction Supervisor:

1. supervise the use of the rink by the public and by special groups;
2. maintain the rink building including operation of wood stove;
3. maintain ice surface including the clearing of snow and flooding on a daily basis (weather permitting);
4. lend and sharpen skates, with responsible handling of related cash receipts;
5. provide emergency first aid if required;
6. represent Meewasin with the public and act as goodwill ambassadors;
7. maintain records and statistics as required;
8. operate and monitor the fire pit when in use;
9. other duties related to the rink operation as assigned.

**JOB SPECIFICATIONS**

No experience required, although candidates may be evaluated based on their relative experience.

The ability to perform strenuous manual labour for lengthy periods in all winter conditions.

Basic first aid course required.

Evening and weekend work required.

Knowledge of occupational health and safety requirements as they relate to this position.
